

Materials:

Hook: Nymph & Streamer, Down Eye, 2X Long, 2X Heavy

Hook Size: 10

Weighted: Lead or non lead wire

Thread: UNI-Thread 8/0 color of body

Tail: Barred Mallard Flank Tail

Hackle: color of the body

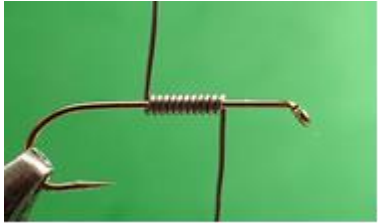
Belly: Contrast color of Body

Body: Dubbing, Floss, or Madeira thread, color to match the hackle

56er

Debarb the hook.
Add 10 turns of
wire. Create a
thread base on
shank back to the
bend of the hook.



Add a tail using
barred mallard flank.



Tie in hackle
feather.



Tie in the under
belly.



Tie in body material.



Wind the body
material forward to
the eye and tie off.
Remember, do not
crowd the eye.



Bring the under belly
forward and tie off.



Palmer the hackle
feather forward, tie
off, and whip finish.



The finished 56er.
