

## **Wooly Bugger Materials:**

**Hook: Down eye, 2X long, 2X heavy.**

**Hook Size: 10**

**Bead: Black Ni 4.0mm, or 5/32"**

**Weighted: Lead or non lead wire**

**Thread: UNI-Thread 8/0 color of body**

**Tail: Marabou**

**Ribbing: Copper wire**

**Hackle: Color to complement the body**

**Body: Chenille, black, brown, olive**

# Wooly Bugger

Debarb the hook, add a bead and then add 10 turns of non lead wire.



Put down a thread base to the bend.



Add marabou for the tail.



Tie in copper wire and then hackle feather.



Tie in chenille and wrap forward to behind the eye.



Wrap hackle forward and make a half hitch to secure it.



Counter wrap the wire forward to eye, wiggle wire thru hackle.
