
January 31 at 10:01pm · Hollister, MO

Here's a great recipe for these cold winter days:

Slow Cooker French Onion Soup

6 -10.5 oz. cans condensed beef broth undiluted

6 Lg. onions sliced (I used yellow onions)

1-1/2 tsp Worcestershire Sauce

¼ cup butter

Put broth in 5 qt., slow cooker, add Worcestershire sauce. Sauté onions in butter till crisp tender! This may take several batches to get all of the onions sauté depending on the size of your skillet! Add to broth, put on low for 5-6 hours!

Once onions are tender, ladle soup into oven proof bowls, place slice of French bread on soup and liberally sprinkle with shredded fresh mozzarella and gruyere cheeses, place under broiler until cheeses begin to melt. ENJOY

I don't have oven proof bowl, so I toast slices of French bread under broiler, then spread shredded cheeses on toast and broil until cheese reaches desired stage of melting! I then cut the cheese toast into crouton sized pieces and add to the soup!
