Fur Bug (per-emerger)

Everybody has a favorite or secret fly in their fly box. This fly was created by Bill Huyett and do not know if he has shared it with others. It is called the Fur Bug.





Bill makes up his own dubbing materials and here is his recipe. Knitting yarn (light coral) – 2 parts, Glo Bug yarn (peachy king) – 4 parts, and Glo Bug yarn (apricot supreme) – 2 parts. He cut them into $\frac{1}{2}$ " sections and blends them in a coffee grinder.

Other materials are: Hook: Jig hook 1/124 oz peach color Thread: Peach or Red 8/0

I am using a TMC403BLJ size 16 with 1/100 oz salmon color.



I put down a thread base on the hook, and create a dubbing loop, then bring my thread back to the head.



Put in my dubbing materials in the dubbing loop and dub to the front of the head, tie down the dubbing loop, cutting off the excess and whip finish. Bill said "can wrap back and forth the dubbing for thickness."







Use a dubbing brush and trim off excess. Any guess on this fly, ask Bill. bandihuyett45@yahoo.com
