Even at the trading post in Roaring River had them. She said the white and back caught the most trout.

Easy fly to tie and we know that the string fly, the mega worm and the Bed Spread fly all in white catch trout. Going to Bennett Springs or Roaring River, tie some up and give them a try.



Materials:
Hook: 90 Degree jig hook 1/100 oz, size 10
Thread: UNI-Thread 8/0 White
Tail: White Marabou

Thread: UNI-Thread 8/0 White
Body: White chenille small

Tie some up in black. Better yet, tie your favorite color that catches trout.

Bream Killer

Materials:
Hook: TMC 3762 or TMC5212BL
Hook size: 1
Thread: UNI-Tread 8/0 Black
Body: Black Chenille
Leg: White rubber
Wing: Gray squirrel tail

The Fly tied by Mack Wilson, Fort Smith, AR. Mack said it is an old pattern a friend showed him 25 years ago. Very simple and very productive. Use as a dropper under a hopper/popper or indicator or just straight and watch your line.

Mack also ties a yellow hopper and a yellow popper. I like his R.K.Craw.
