Fishing Reports:

David Ransin provided this account, via email on 12/4/2023

Three very best friends and I floated the upper Current from Baptist Camp to Akers this last weekend Friday to Sunday, not another soul on the water, but a few fishing from the banks below Cedar Grove and above Akers. We are not fair-weather floaters, but Sunday was gorgeous ! Low water gave us some bumps and rubs here and there but no get out and pushes unless someone chose the wrong fork... The water was crystal clear, full of fish but none were interested in my many offerings other than a nice 14" Bo that took my small spoon nose bass fingerling on an ultralight spinning rig and then just after sunset Saturday at camp where an 18" Bo fought and stripped line on the same rig until he finally surrendered. Until I landed him I thought it was a Smallie ! I normally catch and release, but since I get to fish so little, I like to eat a few now and then... He was wonderful with just a few pats of butter wrapped in foil on the fire and I brought my frozen steak home instead. Sunday was the same until mid-morning when the big brother of the others showed up and I brought him home to share with my wife while the Chiefs lost to the Packers. In all, 3 days of endless casting, 4 strikes produced 3 fish, lost only a single fly which snagged on a low limb I failed to notice while twisting thru some tight and turbulent S turns !

12/15/2023 thru 12/17/2023

Rod Pennington, Kim Schultz, Bob Randall, and Pat Taggart journeyed to Montauk State Park to partake in the late season catch-and-release. It was generally cold and overcast. Upon my entering the park, I was driving and Bob was a passenger, I was met by one of the park rangers and told that I was exceeding the 20 mile per hour speed limit! Oh well, I was at least going below the previous 30 mile per hour speed limit. Bob and I met up with Kim and Rod, and fished the afternoon. Kim and Rod had arrived earlier and had good success. Over the next two days most of us, except me, had good luck catching may fish. There was occasional caddis hatches going on; however, the flies were in the size #28 variety. I tried a #16 renegade but no takers, some lookers. Wet flies, particularly cracklebacks, dark muddler minnows, woolies, and soft hackle flies were the most productive. We all fished from the spring down to behind the restaurant/motel. On Saturday night, Rod was the chef and cooked a really good batch of quail and fish. The other courses were salad and veggies. Kim was the breakfast chef and he cooks a good batch of eggs and bacon!
