
## The February Meeting is on February 1 at 6 pm

#### Fishing Reports:

January 22, 2024

Jim Rogers:

Howdy

We found 8 fishermen frozen from the waist up at Bennett.

Just kidding, not much to report here.

Rod Pennington:

Nothing. Went to stockton on Jan 2nd. Fish gone. Circumstances and weather prevented any additional trips

January 24th, 2024

The 2023-2024 Bennett Spring Winter Catch and Release portion so far has been fantastic! 40 to 50+ fish days are common and many 3-4 lb fish have been landed and there are still many large and full pools of fish in the park especially in Zone 2. Great success has also been found at the Barclay Conservation Area which has recently been home to some great quality Brown Trout (14-22 inches). These fish have been caught on a variety of different flies and lures however just a few stand out such as, KastMaster Trout Spoons, Mepps Agila Spinners, Rooster tail Spinners, Stonefly And Small Baitfish Fly limitations.

As For Bennett Springs The Usual Flies are recommended. 1/80 oz Mop Flies (Cream, White and Peach) #12-20 Crackle Backs (Dark Olive, Bennet Blue, White and Black), 1/80 oz Mega Worm (white), Glo Balls (Popsicle, White, Olive, Jimi Hendrix and clown) John Deere Fly (Olive, Bumble Bee and Pink) L Would Personally recommend Bottom Bouncing with Mop Flies. Bottom Bouncing is both an easy and deadly method of catching trout on both Fly and Conventional Gear Downsizing line and tippet to 2-4 lb sest (5ox, fox and 7x tippet) is suggested to ensure success in clear water.

March 7, 2024


