Currently, there are only three members of the Executive Committee—John Owensby, Dick Owensby, and Bill Huyett. There is one opening for the 2-year term, and two openings for the 1-year term. Now that I have entered my golden years, turned 70 last October, I have noticed that I am not as spry as I once was. I have noticed my balance is not what it used to be and getting in and out of the streams has become more difficult. Wading out in the streams is a little more challenging, as I have slipped and slided on slick rocks and muddy stream banks. My fix has become metal studs at-tached to my wading shoes/boots and a wading staff. My Reddington wading boots, top picture, were pre-drilled for tungsten studs. I used a 1/4" nut driver to screw the studs into the soles, usually ten studs per shoe/boot. You can use different designs to get a good grip. I suggest using a drill bit and drill to drill starter holes; otherwise, you better wear gloves to screw the studs in. I bought an adjustable wading staff, so you can customize the length for your liking. The staff helps me steady myself in the stream and getting up/down the stream bank. You can anchor the staff and lean into it as you fish.
