

Fly Fishing for Beginners—sponsored by the Missouri Department of Conservation, Springfield Nature Center. Classes were at the Nature Center on June 14, 2025, and June 21, 2025. The Springfield Chapter had a fishing outing at Mountain Springs Trout Park for the students on June 26, and an outing to Roaring River State Park on June 28.

Comments from the lead instructor Bob Randall are as follows:

The Beginning FF class is over. I would say it was a success even though I can think of changes that could be made for improvement. Attendance varied from class to class. Not everyone who signed up attended. Who knows why? Several people were very enthusiastic and said so. Membership applications were handed out the first day and Kim said he received 12 completed applications. Several people expressed interest in attending our meetings and I told them to watch for our newsletter.

Of the 20 we expected, 4 didn't show (changed their minds, forgot, family emergency) at all. Several people learned about it and asked if they could join and I allowed them to participate. First class attendance: 16, 2nd: 13, 3rd: 11, 4th: 6. We anticipated that it would be difficult to get people to attend both classes, as well as both field trips.

There were two classes with both classroom activity and casting practice. That was followed by two field trips, one to Mountain Springs Trout Park and one to Roaring River State Park. I'm disappointed to report that I do not believe MDC stocked the educational pool the night before the field trip even though I had been told that they would do so. Even so, most caught some fish.

Rudy Martinez, Nature Center manager, expressed interest in having the class again. He said he would check the Nature Center calendar for September. I told him to let me know and we would see what we could do. I would like to have this matter brought before either the Executive Committee or at a club meeting to see if we wanted to put on another class. I don't feel that I should make that decision on my own without group approval. I leave this to you as I don't expect to be able to attend the Ex. Com. meeting due to family plans. However, Rudy has to know sooner rather than later due to their schedule process. Several people have told me that they have friends who have expressed interest in attending a future class.

For the most part, we had enough mentors to assist the students. I called on several fly anglers from outside of our club, one from the TriLakes FF and two from SW FF to assist as mentors. I suppose one or two more for casting practice would not have hurt. I felt that the events created enthusiasm and a feeling of participation for both the club members and the participants. I am eager to do it again.






Fishing at Roaring River State Park: Linda's big fish!!


