

We won't be able to take a free field trip to Mountain Springs Trout Park, however I may be able to negotiate a discount for an hour of catch and release fishing which will be an optional event. We will still have a field trip to Roaring River State Park. The dates are September 13 & 20 for the classroom/casting part at the Springfield Conservation Nature Center and October 4 for the field trip to Roaring River.

Just as we did last time, we will furnish the equipment sans eyewear and cap. We will also try to arrange fishing for no charge at Roaring River.

All sign-up will go through the Nature Center's website. You will have to sign up for each class separately, however, the field trip to RRSP will be arranged in the classroom.


